washingtonpost Anita Hill is urging senators to "push the pause button" on plans to hold a hearing next week on allegations against Judge Brett Kavanaugh of an alleged sexual assault decades ago. She said the FBI should be allowed to investigate, as his accuser has requested. Hill, who testified before the Senate Judiciary Committee in 1991 that now-Justice Clarence Thomas had sexually harassed her, said senators should avoid a "sham" proceeding. "The American public really is expecting something more," Hill said during an appearance on ABC's "Good Morning America." "They want to know that the Senate takes this seriously."
