Models an adventurous civility;

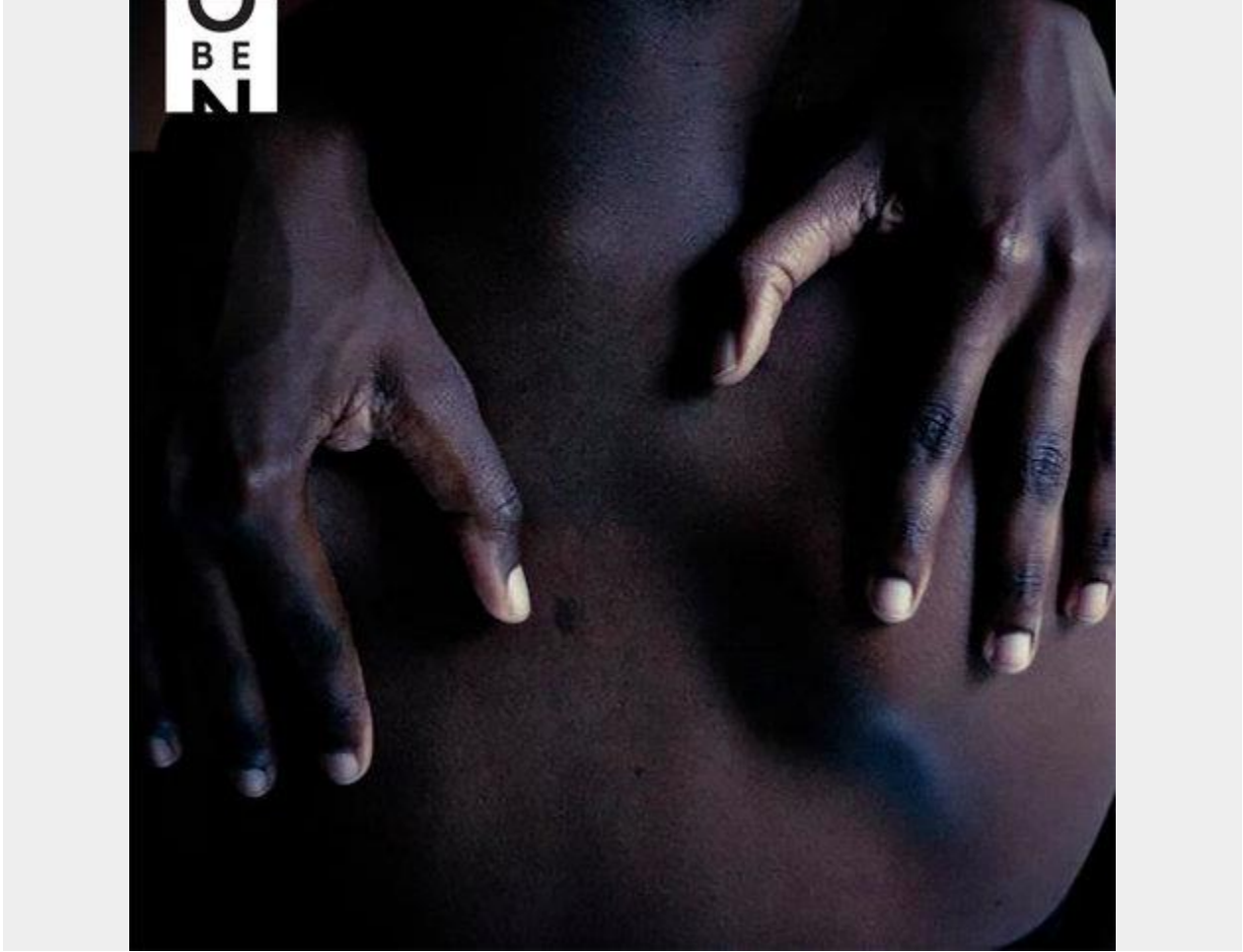
Patiently calls forth the best in ourselves and others.
